A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Michael McElligott called the March 11, 2020, Regular Board Meeting of the High Ridge Quantum Community Development District to order at 9:31 a.m. in the Conference Room of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A. located at Centurion Tower, 1601 Forum Place, Suite 400, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401.
